<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with ACS Playground Adventures for the repair of the Fitlot structure at Murray Park that was damaged as a result of the March 31, 2023, EF-3 Tornado.	
<b>FISCAL IMPACT</b>	The amount is not to exceed \$92,000.00, and funding is available from FEMA, Account No. 270459-G45DF231 (\$69,000.00) and Insurance Reimbursement, Account No. 210459-S45B716 (\$23,000.00).	
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	Approval of the resolution.	
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<p>The Fitlot structure was severely damaged as a result of the March 31, 2023, EF-3 Tornado. Prior to the damage, the structure was heavily utilized and the repair will return this amenity to new condition for all users to enjoy.</p> <p>The Fitlot structure was donated and ACS Playground Adventures originally installed the structure. Vendor selection was made utilizing the State Sourcwell Contract, No. 030117-LSI.</p>
