



1 No. 21,918 (November 2, 2020), is hereby amended to reflect an increase in the operating budget for Street  
2 Fund Departments of Four Million, Six Hundred Thirteen Thousand, Eight Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars  
3 (\$4,613,875.00) to Twenty-Five Million, Nine Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand, Thirty-Three Dollars  
4 (\$25,965,033.00).

5 **Section 3. Records.** The Director of Finance & Treasurer is directed to maintain appropriate records  
6 which provide greater detail for the adjustments set forth in this ordinance and as reflected in the materials  
7 provided to the Board of Directors on December 8, 2020.

8 **Section 4. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase,  
9 or word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration  
10 or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full  
11 force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not  
12 originally a part of the ordinance.

13 **Section 5. Repealer.** All ordinances, resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this  
14 ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

15 **Section 6. Emergency Clause.** *The City's ability to properly maintain its budgets and to account for*  
16 *its funds is essential to maintain the public health, safety and welfare; an emergency is, therefore, declared*  
17 *to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.*
