

1 **WHEREAS**, the Fleet Services Department requests approval to enter into the fifth one (1)-year term
2 of the Public Agency Service Agreement, in a form and format approved by the City Attorney, commencing
3 January 31, 2023, through and including January 30, 2024.

4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**
5 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

6 **Section 1.** Pursuant to the authority set forth in Arkansas Code Ann. § 25-20-108 (West Supp. 2020)
7 and pursuant to the authority set forth in Arkansas Code Ann. § 19-11-250 (West Supp. 2020), the City
8 Manager is authorized to enter into the fifth one (1)-year term of the Public Agency Service Agreement
9 commencing January 31, 2023, through and including January 30, 2024, in a form to be approved by the
10 City Attorney; to provide Maintenance, Repair and Fueling Services for LRCVB vehicles and equipment.
11 The sixth and final one (1)-year term shall commence January 31, 2024, by mutual agreement of the parties.

12 **Section 2. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
13 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
14 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
15 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
16 resolution.

17 **Section 3. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
18 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
