

1 (10) months to begin on or about March 1, 2023, through January 1, 2024, with a final report due
2 February 1, 2024.

3 **Section 4.** All payments are conditioned upon entry into a contract amendment for the extension of
4 services; further, nothing in this resolution limits the ability of the City, in its sole discretion, to procure
5 similar services from another vendor during the term of the contract authorized here.

6 **Section 5. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
7 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
8 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and
9 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
10 resolution.

11 **Section 6. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts of the same, including but
12 not limited to Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 15,626 (February 15, 2022), that are inconsistent
13 with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
