



1       **Section 2.** The term for this grant from the Windgate Foundation shall commence on May 15, 2021,  
2 and shall go through and include June 1, 2025.

3       **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
4 word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or  
5 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and  
6 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the  
7 ordinance.

8       **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, including but not limited to, Ordinance No. 22,067  
9 (November 16, 2021), resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this  
10 resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
