<p>SYNOPSIS</p> <p>FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION</p> <p>CITIZEN PARTICIPATION</p> <p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>The Little Rock Police Department is requesting approval to allow the City Manager to amend the current contract with the architectural firm of Roark, Perkins, Perry & Yelvington to reflect their participation in the design, procurement and actual placement of furniture for the 12th Street Station.</p> <p>The cost for this request is \$40,295.82 which will increase the “not to exceed amount to \$892,195.82.” Funding comes from the 12th Street Contingency Fund.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>N/A</p> <p>The architectural firm of Roark, Perkins, Perry & Yelvington worked with both Division Commanders and other members of the Command Staff to design, select and solicit bids from State Contract vendors to provide both practical and functional furniture for the 12th Street Station. The fee for this project is 6.5% of the actual cost of the furniture purchased (\$619,935.57). They were very instrumental in securing the correct furniture and accessories.</p>
