

1 **RESOLUTION NO. _____**

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3 **A RESOLUTION TO IDENTIFY EXPENDITURES IN VARIOUS WARDS**
4 **FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS FUNDED FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE**
5 **2022 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS FOR STREET AND**
6 **DRAINAGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

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8 **WHEREAS**, the electors of the City of Little Rock, Arkansas approved the issuance of Capital
9 Improvement Bonds for Streets and Drainage Improvements in order to accomplish the public purposes set
10 forth in Ordinance 22,192, which was adopted on November 15, 2022; and,

11 **WHEREAS**, it is desirable to fund the identified 2023, 2024 and 2025 projects from the 2022 Capital
12 Improvement Bonds for Streets and Drainage in the various Wards.

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**
14 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

15 **Section 1.** The Board of Directors intends to accomplish the following list of Street and Drainage
16 Improvement Projects in Ward 1 with approximately Four Million, Five Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand,
17 Eight Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$4,584,857.00):

- 18 a) Broadway Street Drainage, from West 33rd Street to West 34th Street.
- 19 b) West 24th Street Reconstruction, from Valentine Street to Valmar Street.
- 20 c) West 10th Street Reconstruction, from Oak Street to Maple Street.
- 21 d) West 13th Street Reconstruction, from Fair Park Boulevard to Fillmore Street.
- 22 e) Bishop Street Sidewalk, from West 18th Street to Wright Avenue.
- 23 f) East 39th Street Drainage, from Park Avenue to Riddick Street.
- 24 g) East 38th Street Drainage, located east of Springer Boulevard.
- 25 h) Rock Street Crosswalks at 6th Street and at River Market Avenue
- 26 i) Resurfacing – Street resurfacing priorities throughout the Ward

27 **Section 2.** The Board of Directors intends to accomplish the following list of Street and Drainage
28 Improvement Projects in Ward 2 with approximately Four Million, Five Hundred Eighty Four Thousand,
29 Eight Hundred Fifty Seven Dollars (\$4,584,857.00):

- 30 a) Valley Drive Reconstruction, from Valley Drive, south approximately 450 linear-feet.
- 31 b) Woodson Road Reconstruction, from Browning Road, north approximately 350 linear-feet.
- 32 c) Sidewalk – Construct new and replacement sidewalk priorities throughout the Ward.
- 33 d) Stump Creek Channel Improvements, east of Reck Road.
- 34 e) Larch Road Drainage, south of West 54th Street.

- 1 f) Rinke Road at Republic Lane Drainage Improvements.
- 2 g) West 57th Street Drainage, west of Hopson Drive.
- 3 h) Azalea Drive Drainage, from Lantana Road to Juniper Road.
- 4 i) Redwood Drive Drainage at Watson Elementary School.
- 5 j) Resurfacing – Street resurfacing priorities throughout the Ward.

6 **Section 3.** The Board of Directors intends to accomplish the following list of Street and Drainage
7 Improvement Projects in Ward 3 with approximately Four Million, Five Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand,
8 Eight Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$4,584,857.00):

- 9 a) North Polk Street Reconstruction, from Lee Avenue to F Street.
- 10 b) F Street Reconstruction, from North Spruce Street to North Palm Street.
- 11 c) Indian Trail Sidewalk. from Keightly Drive to Jimerson Creek Bridge.
- 12 d) Durwood Road at Brownwood Road Drainage Improvements.
- 13 e) L Street Drainage, between North Tyler Street and North Polk Street.
- 14 f) Mellon Street at H Street Drainage Improvements.
- 15 g) Kavanaugh Boulevard at North University Avenue Drainage Improvements.
- 16 h) R Street at Fillmore Street Drainage Improvements.
- 17 i) 5201 Kavanaugh Boulevard Drainage Improvements.
- 18 j) Resurfacing – Street resurfacing priorities throughout the Ward.

19 **Section 4.** The Board of Directors intends to accomplish the following list of Street and Drainage
20 Improvement Projects in Ward 4 with approximately Four Million, Five Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand,
21 Eight Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$4,584,857.00):

- 22 a) Hidden Valley Drive Sidewalk, from Rodney Parham Road to Gila Valley Drive.
- 23 b) Autumn Road Widening, from #408 Autumn Road to Birchwood Drive,
- 24 c) Reservoir Road Widening, from Northedge Road to Meredith Court.
- 25 d) Sidewalk – Construct new and replacement sidewalk priorities throughout the Ward.
- 26 e) #4 Bridgeport Court Drainage.
- 27 f) Reservoir Road at Claremore Street Drainage Improvements.
- 28 g) Teton Forest at Shawnee Forest Drainage.
- 29 h) Buttermilk Road Drainage, near #26 and #28 Buttermilk Road.
- 30 i) Hidden Valley Drainage, near #3303 Hidden Valley Drive.
- 31 j) Montrose Drive at Longlea Drive Drainage.
- 32 k) Resurfacing – Street resurfacing priorities throughout the Ward.

33 **Section 5.** The Board of Directors intends to accomplish the following list of Street and Drainage
34 Improvement Projects in Ward 5 with approximately Four Million, Five Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand,
35 Eight Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$4,584,857.00):

- 1 a) Bella Rosa at Taylor Loop Creek Bridge.
- 2 b) Kirk Road at Rahling Road Traffic Signal.
- 3 c) Chenal Boulevard at Loyola Drive Right-Turn Lane.
- 4 a) Chenal Boulevard at Chenal Club Intersection Improvements.
- 5 d) Adell Drive Drainage outfall to Ridgehaven Court.
- 6 e) #209 Weston Court Drainage.
- 7 f) Johnson Ranch Road Cross Drain Replacement at three (3) locations.
- 8 g) Morrison Court Drainage Improvements.
- 9 h) #15808 Taylor Loop Creek Drainage Improvements.
- 10 i) Chenal Parkway at Fitzroy Drainage Improvements.
- 11 j) Kirk Road at Wellington Village Road Drainage Improvements.
- 12 k) Resurfacing – Street resurfacing priorities throughout the Ward.

13 **Section 6.** The Board of Directors intends to accomplish the following list of Street and Drainage
14 Improvement Projects in Ward 6 with approximately Four Million, Five Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand,
15 Eight Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$4,584,857.00):

- 16 a) Boyd Street Reconstruction, from 43rd Street to 44th Street.
- 17 b) Arthur Lane Widening, from Gamble Road to Atkins Road.
- 18 c) West 30th Street Reconstruction, from John Barrow Road to Ludwig Street.
- 19 d) Sidewalk – Construct new and replacement sidewalk priorities throughout the Ward.
- 20 e) Cherrybark Drive Drainage, from #115 Cherrybark Drive to Chenal Parkway.
- 21 f) Pine Summit Court Drainage outfall, from #8110 Pine Summit Court to Vancouver Drive.
- 22 g) Cherrywood Court Drainage outfall near #12 Cherrywood Court.
- 23 h) Dorchester Drive Drainage near #2213 Dorchester Drive.
- 24 i) Dryad Lane Drainage, near #208 Dryad Lane.
- 25 j) Leander Drive at 16th Street Drainage.
- 26 k) Walker Street Drainage at Rock Creek Bridge.
- 27 l) Shackelford Road Drainage, north of Col Glenn Road.
- 28 m) 35th Street Drainage, from Zion Street to Walker Street.
- 29 n) Resurfacing – Street resurfacing priorities throughout the Ward.

30 **Section 7.** The Board of Directors intends to accomplish the following list of Street and Drainage
31 Improvement Projects in Ward 7 with approximately Four Million, Five Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand,
32 Eight Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$4,584,857.00):

- 33 a) South Shackelford Road at Col. Glenn Road Intersection Improvements.
- 34 b) Vimy Ridge Road Widening at rail crossing and south of Alexander Road to Pleasant Hill Road.
- 35 c) West 41st Street Drainage at Oak Park Drive.

- 1 d) Heinke Road Cross Drain Replacement, south of Johnson Road.
- 2 e) Greenland Cove Drainage near #107 Greenland Cove.
- 3 f) David O Dodd Drainage near #11400 David O Dodd Road.
- 4 g) West Windsor Drive at Brookview Drive Drainage Improvements.
- 5 h) Crystal Valley Drainage at #12925 Crystal Valley Drive.
- 6 i) Preston Drive Area Drainage Improvements.
- 7 j) Resurfacing – Street resurfacing priorities throughout the Ward.

8 **Section 8.** The Board of Directors intends to accomplish the following list of Street Improvement
9 Projects considered to be of City-wide importance with approximately One Million, Two Hundred Eighty-
10 Three Thousand Dollars (\$1,283,000.00):

- 11 b) Kanis Road at Panther Branch Drive Intersection Improvements.
- 12 c) Chenal Boulevard at Gamble Road Intersection Improvements.

13 **Section 9. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
14 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
15 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
16 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
17 resolution.

18 **Section 10. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
19 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
