<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>The Little Rock Police Department is requesting an amendment to Resolution No. 14,900, for the purchase of a Computer-Aided Dispatch (CAD) System in order to ensure proper disbursement of funds and to expedite the system installation.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p>	<p>The overall allocation of \$4,786,244.00 for the complete CAD system will not change. The initial resolution allocated \$3,764,303.00 for the CAD system and a total of five (5) years of maintenance, \$269,081.00 for estimated taxes, and a 20% contingency fee. The amended resolution would allow disbursement of funds directly to vendors in the following areas: CAD System, Microsoft Licensing, Fire Department Mobile Devices and related equipment, workspace modification (computer mounting, power, cabling, etc.), and additional services and support providing funding allows. Funding will be available through a short-term financing note to be issued in 2019.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>During the contracting phase with Motorola, while reviewing line items, it was determined that the City would benefit by purchasing certain licenses and components directly from the vendor instead of through Motorola. The original resolution only authorized purchases through Motorola and requires an amendment to allow purchase directly from other vendors.</p>
