<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>For over (30) years the Building Codes Division has performed Plumbing, Natural Gas and Mechanical Inspections outside the City Limits of Little Rock. Passage of this ordinance would eliminate the requirements for City Inspectors to make inspections outside the City Limits.</p> <p>Will reduce the costs associated with performing inspections outside the City Limits.</p> <p>Approval of the ordinance.</p> <p>Due to the reduction in staff in 2008, the City has two (2) Plumbing and Gas Inspectors and two (2) Mechanical Inspectors. By eliminating these inspections, it will allow staff to better serve the citizens and contractors in the City. If approved, the effective date for implementation will be July 7, 2016.</p>
