<p><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p> <p><b>FISCAL IMPACT</b></p> <p><b>RECOMMENDATION</b></p> <p><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Crafton, Tull &amp; Associates, Inc., for Professional Engineering Consultant Services for the Fourche Dam Pike at Interstate 440 Traffic Signal Improvements.</p> <p>Amount for Engineering Services is not to exceed \$72,000.00. Funding for this project is from the Arkansas Economic Development Agency with local match funds from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds and the Capital Improvement Bonds.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>The project includes improvements to the Fourche Dam Pike at Interstate 440 interchange, north of the railroad tracks, as well as railroad crossing and signal improvements. This project as a part of the overall plan to improve traffic flow and encourage economic development in the Little Rock River Port area. Crafton, Tull and Associates, Inc., was selected through a statements of qualifications process to provide design work for these projects.</p>
