11	WHEREAS, Township Builders, Inc., was the lowest responsive, responsible bid meeting
12	specifications.
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
14	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
15	SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Township
16	Builders, Inc., for Malloy Street Improvements in an amount not to Eight Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand,
17	Eight Hundred Four Dollars (\$852,804.00), which is the base bid amount of Seven Hundred Ten
18	Thousand, Six Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$710,670.00), plus 20% contingencies.
19	SECTION 2. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and
20	Compensating Use Tax Funds as authorized by Resolution No. 13,699.
21	SECTION 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase,
22	or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
23	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
24	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
25	resolution.
26	SECTION 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent
27	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
28	<b>SECTION 5.</b> This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
