8	WHEREAS, the City has elected to use a rotation basis for Contract Wrecker Service; and,	
9	WHEREAS, after a competitive selection process, four (4) companies have been deemed to be	
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11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY	
12	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:	
13	<b>Section 1.</b> The City Manager is authorized to enter into towing service contracts with:	
14	A. Metro Towing & Recovery, LLC;	
15	B. Asher Wrecker Service, Inc.;	
16	C. Routh Wrecker Service, Inc.; and	
17	D. Adams Towing, Inc.	
18	Section 2. The term of these towing service contracts shall be from 12:01 AM, October 1, 2016.	
19	through September 30, 2017. If the City and all contract wrecker companies agree, the term may renewed	
20	two (2) times in one (1)-year increments by fully-executed addendum to each Towing Service Contract no	
21	less than ninety (90) calendar days prior to expiration of the then-current term.	
22	Section 3. The terms and conditions of these towing service contracts shall be consistent with the	
23	RFQ specifications, and the agreements shall be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney in order to	
24	ensure that the City's interests are met.	
25	Section 4. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or	
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or	
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force an	
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the	
29	resolution.	
30	Section 5. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with	
31	the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
