SYNOPSIS FISCAL IMPACT	Approval of an ordinance ratifying the issuance of a Purchase Order to Sunbelt Fire, Inc., located in Fairhope, Alabama, for the repairs to Engine 15 (13D138), Vehicle Identification Dumber 4ENLAAA87D1008102. An adjuster with Arkansas Municipal League obtained a quote from Sunbelt Fire, Inc., and the deductible amount is not to exceed \$1,000.00, and is available through the Fleet Wreck Damage Account No. 600031-61250. An additional estimate may be submitted for any unforeseen repairs needed once the authorized repair work has started. The insurance company has paid \$80,030.81.

BACKGROUND	Engine 15 (13D138), VIN is 4ENLAAA87D1008102, frontline 2013-E-ONE Cyclone Pump Truck used by the Little Rock Fire Department (LRFD), Station 15, is the busiest engine in the LRFD fleet. The unit was wrecked and needs major repairs to the specialty Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) Systems. An authorized E-ONE Dealer will perform the repair in order to restore the apparatus to OEM manufacturer's specifications. Sunbelt Fire, Inc., in Fairhope, Alabama, is the nearest authorized dealer to perform these repairs.	

BACKGROUND CONTINUED

An adjuster with Arkansas Municipal League worked with Sunbelt Fire, Inc., to obtain a quote for the repair which totals \$81,507.25 (parts and labor). The insurance company paid \$80,030.81 (minus \$1,000.00 deductible) toward the claim.
