SYNOPSIS	In an effort maximize the Land Bank's revitalization efforts, the Land Bank Commission and staff would like to accept the donation of the ten (10) properties located at West 35 <sup>th</sup> Street. All ten (10) parcels are 7,000 square-foot undeveloped lots, and sewer is present.

BACKGROUND	The City has studied numerous methods to assemble and convey property that may pose an environmental or adverse impact to Little Rock neighborhoods. Accepting the donation of underutilized parcels of property is an efficient and cost effective means of reaching the City's revitalization goals.	

## BACKGROUND CONTINUED

For a number of years various neighborhood groups, the Community Housing Advisory Board and the Little Rock Land Bank Commission have studied ways to improve neighborhood quality through the acquisition, purchase, and conveyance of underutilized properties.
