Moore Department City Manager **SYNOPSIS** The applicant is proposing to amend the previously-approved PD-R, Planned Development - Residential, for Phases 6 and 7 of the Wildwood Place Subdivision to add additional land area and additional lots to the previously-approved plat area. FISCAL IMPACT None. **RECOMMENDATION** Staff recommends approval of the requested PD-R zoning. The Planning Commission voted to recommend approval of the PD-R zoning by a vote of 8 ayes, 0 nays and 3 absent. BACKGROUND The applicant is proposing to amend the previously-approved PD-R, Planned Development - Residential, for Phases 6 and 7 of the Wildwood Place Subdivision to add additional land area and additional lots to the previously approved plat area. The applicant is proposing to increase the number of lots for this development from 184 to 206. The lots are proposed with an average lot size of fifty (50) feet by 110 feet. The development is proposed with 4.75 acres of common open space within tracts. The development is indicated with twenty (20)-foot front setbacks and five (5)-foot side-yard setbacks. The rear yard is proposed with a twenty-five (25)foot setback.
