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12	WHEREAS, Public Works is in need of eight (8) Automated Side Loader Refuse Trucks to		
13	replace older units that have excessive maintenance expenses and down time; and,		
14	WHEREAS, by utilizing the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Contract, the City can		
15	purchase eight (8) Automated Side Loader Refuse Trucks from River City Hydraulic Company		
16	for the Public Works Department, at a cost of Two Million, Two Hundred Six Thousand, Six		
17	Hundred Forty Dollars (\$2,206,640.00).		
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE		
19	CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
20	Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract		
21	with River City Hydraulic Company for the purchase of eight (8) Automated Side Loader Refuse		
22	Trucks, utilizing the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Contract, for the total amount of Two		
23	Million, Two Hundred Six Thousand, Six Hundred Forty Dollars (\$2,206,640.00).		
24	Section 2. Funds for this purchase are allocated in the Waste Disposal Fund.		
25	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause,		
26	phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such		
27	declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall		
28	remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional		
29	were not originally a part of the resolution.		
30	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are		
31	inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such		

1	inconsistency.
