| SYNOPSIS | The applicant is appealing the Planning Commission's denial of the requested waiver of the Master Street Plan Requirement to construct one-half street improvements for approximately 307 linear-feet of Kanis Road in association with an approved PD-C zoning titled West Kanis Storage PD-C (Z-5502-I), located at 17302 Kanis Road. |
| FISCAL IMPACT | None. |
| RECOMMENDATION | Staff recommends denial of the requested waiver. The Planning Commission voted to recommend denial by a vote of 5 ayes, 4 nays and 2 absent. |
| BACKGROUND | The West Kanis Storage PD-C (Z-5502-I) was approved by the Planning Commission on November 18, 2021. This application is also on the January 18, 2022, Board of Directors Agenda. As part of the PD-C project, the applicant requested a waiver of the Master Street Plan Construction Requirements for approximately 307 linear-feet of Kanis Road adjacent to 17301 Kanis Road. |
