4	ENTERTAINMEN DISTRICT, FOR TWO (2) DAYS, ON FEBRUARY 4,
5	2021, AND MARCH 4, 2021; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
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7	WHEREAS, on July 23, 2019, the Board of Directors of the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, passed
8	Little Rock, Ark., Ordinance No. 21,761, which permitted the creation of an District pursuant to Arkansas
9	State Law and City Ordinance; and,
10	WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has determined that the creation of a Temporary Entertainment
11	District as proposed by Ordinance No. 21,761 is appropriate as recommended by the Planning &
12	Development Department.
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
14	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS.
15	Section 1. The Hillcrest Entertainment District is hereby created by the City of Little Rock as a
16	Temporary Entertainment District on January 19, 2021, and subject to Ordinance No. 21,761, as amended
17	and its defined terms.
18	Section 2. Boundaries. The temporary boundaries of the Hillcrest Entertainment District are North
19	Monroe Street, east to Walnut Street; Beechwood Street, between Kavanaugh Boulevard and Woodlawn
20	Drive, and North Palm Street, between Beechwood Street and F Street.
21	Section 3. Timeframe. The days and hours of operation will be February 4, 2021, and March 4, 2021,
22	from 4:00 PM to 9:00 PM.
23	Section 4. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
24	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
25	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
26	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
27	resolution.
28	Section 5. Repealer. The provisions of all technical codes, ordinances and codes of ordinances in
29	conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
