SYNOPSIS	The applicant is requesting approval of a PRD, Planned Residential District, for the construction of a parking area for the use of the apartment tenants.

RECOMMENDATION	Staff recommends approval of the PRD zoning. The Planning Commission voted to recommend approval by a vote of 10 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent.	
BACKGROUND	In 1994, a PD-R, Planned Development - Residential, was approved on this property for the construction of a multi- family residential building with eight (8) units. The multi- family development was not constructed, and the PD-R was revoked by the Board of Directors in 1998.	
	In 2011 a request was made for Development, to construct a pave enclosure to serve the tenants of located across South Park Str withdrawn.	d parking area and dumpster of the Peacock Apartments

The applicant is making this request to expand tenant parking.	
The proposed parking lot would be constructed in	
conformance with accepted best management practices for	
low-impact development or to be paved with either concrete or asphalt.	
A reduced landscaping buffer would be provided between the	
parking lot and the neighboring residence at 101 South Park, owned by the applicant's mother.	
Lastly, an existing storage building would be relocated to the	
rear yard of the residential structure.
