10	WHEREAS, Bids were solicited for improvements for Meadowcliff Sidewalks Phase 2, Project No.		
11	13-7-050, Bid No. 16031; and,		
12	WHEREAS, Cisneros Family Construction, Inc., was the lowest responsive, responsible bid meeting		
13	specifications.		
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
15	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
16	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Cisneros Family		
17	Construction, Inc., in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand, Four Hundred Thirty-Seven		
18	and 69/100 Dollars (\$150,437.69), which is the base bid amount of One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand,		
19	Three Hundred Sixty-Four and 74/100 Dollars (\$125,364.74), plus 20% contingencies.		
20	Section 2. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating		
21	Use Tax Funds and the 2013 Capital Improvements Bonds for Streets and Drainage as authorized by		
22	Resolution No. 13,699 and amended by Resolution No. 14,269.		
23	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
24	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
25	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
26	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the		
27	resolution.		
28	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with		
29	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.		
30	Section 5. This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
