ORDINANCE NO.

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MASTER STREET PLAN (ORDINANCE NO. 20,507), TO ADD AN ALTERNATIVE DESIGN STANDARD ON FRAZIER PIKE (MSP2022-01); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Little Rock Planning Commission has reviewed the amendment and recommends the change.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. An alternate design standard is placed on Frazier Pike, from Roosevelt Road to Zeuber Road, on the Master Street Plan Map (as shown on the attached graphic).

Section 2. The text of the Master Street Plan Section 2: Road Classifications and Designs Standards. is amended to add another alternative design standard for the Minor Arterials with Alternative Design Standards. The text shall be as follows: two (2), eleven (11)-foot travel lanes with sidewalks on each side of the road and no paved shoulders.

Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
