Moore Parks & Recreation Department City Manager **SYNOPSIS** To authorize City Manager to enter into a contract with Landscape Structures, Inc. for a total amount of \$84,291.42 for a new playground at Brodie Creek Park. This project is in Ward 7. FISCAL IMPACT Funding, in the amount of \$84,291.42, is available from the 3/8-Cent Capital portion of the 2011 One (1)-Cent Sales Tax allocated for Parks Capital Upgrades. RECOMMENDATION Approval of the resolution. CITIZEN Staff has collaborated with the Pecan Lake Neighborhood PARTICIPATION Association and other area residents in formulating an improvement plan for the park. The playground is a strongly supported and much needed component of the plan. BACKGROUND This project is made possible by passage of the 3/8-Cent Capital portion of the 2011 One (1)-Cent Sales Tax initiative that was allocated for Park Capital Upgrades. As a matter of proceeding with the use of these funds, Parks & Recreation Staff invited public input from neighborhood associations and other constituencies. Pecan Lake Neighborhood Association had expressed a desire to see what could be determined as an improvement in Brodie Creek Park. Working with staff, a new playground was agreed upon as the appropriate improvement for the park.
