13	the 2013 through 2015 Street and Drainage Improvement Program.			
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY

16	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The City Manager is hereby authorized to approve an amendment to the contract for			
17	appraisals and easement acquisition and to increase the contract ceiling price from the previously-

19	(\$251,000.00), to a new contract total of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00).			
20	SECTION 2. The cost for the contract will be funded from the existing project allocations for the			
21	2013 Capital Improvement Bonds for Streets and Drainage for constructing Street and Drainage			
22	Improvement Projects as authorized by Resolution No. 13,699.			
23	SECTION 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase,			
24	or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or			
25	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and			
26	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the			
27	resolution.			
28	<b>SECTION 4.</b> Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent			
29	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.			
30	<b>SECTION 5.</b> This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
