10	WHEREAS, the Little Rock Zoo recommends safety upgrades to the Big Cat and Great Ape Exhibits;			
11	and,			
12	WHEREAS, the City of Little Rock requested bids for construction of the required improvements at			
13	the Big Cat and Great Ape Exhibits, including the labor and materials for the installation of black oxide			
14	steel safety mesh; and,			
15	WHEREAS, Dayco Construction, Inc., submitted the low bid for the requested construction in the			
16	amount of Two Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$285,000.00).			
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY			
18	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:			
19	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Dayco Construction,			
20	Inc., for upgrades to the Little Rock Zoo's Big Cat Exhibit and Great Ape Exhibit in an amount not to			
21	exceed Three Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$342,000.00), which is the base bid amount of Two			
22	Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$285,000.00) plus 20% for contingencies.			
23	Section 2. Funding for this project will be paid from the Zoo's 3-8 Cent Tax Account, Special Project			
24	326659-TS65A71.			
25	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or			
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or			
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and			
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the			
29	resolution.			
30	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with			
31	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.			
32	Section 5. This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
