<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Redstone Construction Group, Inc., for the Pratt Rimmel Road Extension, Lindsey Road to Frazier Pike, Bid No. 1008.</p> <p>The amount for Construction Services is not to exceed \$2,419,732.55, which is the base bid amount of \$2,016,443.79, plus 20% contingencies. Funding for this project is from a grant through the Delta Regional Authority, with local funds match from Pulaski County and the City of Little Rock. The Little Rock share is from the Job Recruitment/Economic Development set-aside from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>This project provides for construction of a new street to connect the existing Pratt Rimmel Road at Lindsey Road to Frazier Pike, and widening of Frazier Pike from west of Apple Avenue to east of Zueber Road, including a sidewalk on one side. The project also includes traffic signal improvements at Interstate 440 and Lindsey Road. Redstone Construction Group, Inc., was the lowest, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of two (2) bids received for the project.</p>
