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10	WHEREAS, it is critical that the Little Rock Police Department be equipped with reliable forms of
11	vehicular transportation; and,
12	WHEREAS, on January 17, 2018, Formal Bid No. 18109 was issued for the leasing of forty-eight (48)
13	vehicles; and,
14	WHEREAS, it was determined by the Selection Committee that the bid of Enterprise Fleet
15	Management, Inc., was the lowest responsible and responsive bid for a total cost of Two Hundred Forty-
16	Four Thousand, One Hundred Seventy-One Dollars (\$244,171.00).
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
18	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
19	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a one (1)-year contract, with not more than
20	two (2), one (1)-year renewal extensions with Enterprise Fleet Management, Inc., for the leasing of forty-
21	eight (48) vehicles for the Little Rock Police Department.
22	Section 2. The funding for the leased vehicles is available in the Crime Intelligence, Account No
23	105215-65140.
24	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
25	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
26	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
27	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
28	resolution.
29	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
30	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
