SYNOPSIS	The Heights Business Association is seeking Board approval to extend a Temporary Entertainment District to support outdoor dining areas not adjacent to the associated restaurant facility.

BACKGROUND	On September 8, 2022, the City of Little Rock received an application for the Heights Business Association for the extension of the Temporary Entertainment District. The boundaries of the temporary entertainment district runs along Kavanaugh Boulevard, from University Avenue in the west to Polk Street in the east. In addition, the District includes Kavanaugh Boulevard from Cantrell Road running north along the eastern side of Kavanaugh Boulevard to the intersection of Club Road and North Van Buren Street. Finally, the District includes the area zoned for business immediately north of the intersection of Club Road and North Van Buren Street.	
	This application sets the time frame for the Temporary Entertainment District to start October 20, 2022 (5:00 PM – 9:00 PM), October 23, 2022 (1:00 PM – 9:00 PM), October 29, 2022 (10:00 AM – 9:00 PM) and sets the time frame to end on January 19, 2023 (5:00 PM – 9:00 PM).
