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10	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK,		
11	ARKANSAS.		
12	SECTION 1. That the zoning classification of the following described property be changed from R-		
13	3, Single-Family District, to PD-O, Planned Development – Office:		
14	<b>Z-9020</b> : Lot 10 Block 6, Jones and Worthen's Addition City of Little Rock, Pulaski		
15	County, Arkansas, as recorded on Bagley Map 52-38 of the plat records of Pulaski		
16	County, Arkansas.		
17	SECTION 2. That the preliminary site development plan/plat be approved as recommended by the		
18	Little Rock Planning Commission.		
19	<b>SECTION 3.</b> That the change in zoning classification contemplated for Hometown Tax Service Short-		
20	Form PD-O, located at 3008 West 12 <sup>th</sup> Street (Z-9020), is conditioned upon obtaining a final plan approval		
21	within the time specified by Chapter 36, Article VII, Section 36-454 (e) of the Code of Ordinances.		
22	<b>SECTION 4.</b> That the map referred to in Chapter 36 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Little		
23	Rock, Arkansas, and designated district map be and is hereby amended to the extent and in the respects		
24	necessary to affect and designate the change provided for in Section 1 hereof.		
25	<b>SECTION 5.</b> That this ordinance shall not take effect and be in full force until the final approval of		
26	the plan.		
27	SECTION 6. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase,		
28	or word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
29	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and		
30	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the		
31	ordinance.		
32	SECTION 7. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are		
33	inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
