9	WHEDEAS the Poord of Directors recently enproved the purchase from Toogs Sefety Inc. for the
10	WHEREAS, the Board of Directors recently approved the purchase from Teeco Safety, Inc., for the purchase of Less-Than-Lethal Electronic Devises commonly referred to as Tasers for use by the Little
11	Rock Police Department; and,
12	WHEREAS, this purchase was approved as a sole source purchase because it was impractical and
13	unfeasible to bid pursuant to Little Rock, Ark., Ordinance No. 21,090 (August 18, 2015)("LRO 21,090");
14	and,
15	WHEREAS , it is necessary to also purchase four (4)-year warranties for these devices which can also
16	only come from Teeco Safety, Inc., and the cost plus tax of Fifty-One Thousand, Five Hundred Twenty-
17	Four and 30/100 Dollars (\$51,524.30) is in excess of the amount that can be authorized without Board
18	approval;
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
20	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
21	Section 1. Pursuant to the sole source purchase authority granted in LRO 21,090, the City Manager
22	is authorized to purchase warranties for 100 Taser Less-Than-Lethal Electronic Control Devices from
23	Teeco Safety, Inc., in the amount of Fifty-One Thousand, Five Hundred Twenty-Four and 30/100 Dollars
24	(\$51,524.30).
25	Section 2. Funds for this purchase will come from Seized Asset Funds.
26	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
27	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
28	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
29	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
30	resolution.
31	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent
32	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
