BACKGROUND CONTINUED

The property owner does not wish to pursue the previously-approved PRD development, and is requesting that the PRD zoning be revoked and the property be restored to its original R-2 and O-3 zoning.

Approximately ten (10) acres of the property was previously zoned R-2 and approximately 1.67 acres was zoned O-3 (south portion). The applicant is proposing a single-family residential preliminary plat for the property, which was approved by the Planning Commission on September 9, 2021.

The Planning Commission reviewed this request at September 9 2021, meeting and there were no objectors present. All owners of property located within 200 feet of the site, as well as all neighborhood associations registered with the City of Little Rock, were notified of the public hearing.
