IN Affordable Housing, Inc., (IAH) was one of three (3) CHDO's that returned proposals and that were qualified to receive 15% Set-aside HOME Funds under the Federal requirement. IAH will receive \$400,000. The funds will be used to develop three (3) affordable housing units in the City of Little Rock. These costs include acquisition, developer's fees and construction costs. **FISCAL IMPACT** This project is funded by the HUD HOME Investment Partnership Program. The funds are a part of the 15% CHDO (Community Housing Development Organization) Set-aside requirement for certified CHDO's and HOME Program Income. **BACKGROUND** The City of Little Rock receives an annual allocation of HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) Funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to develop and/or rehabilitate housing for low to moderate-income persons. A statutory requirement is that 15% of the HOME Funds be set-aside for nonprofit organizations that meet specific criteria established by HUD and have been certified as CHDOs.
