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3	A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THAT IN ITS 2023 BUDGET, THE
4	CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS, WILL COMMIT TO THE
5	ACQUISITION AND CONSTRUCTION OF A PROPER AND SECURE
6	FACILITY FOR THE STORAGE OF EVIDENCE AND PROPERTY BY
7	THE LITTLE ROCK POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER
8	PURPOSES.
9	I URI OSES.
9	WHEREAS, a careful review of the 2022 Police Operations and Data Analysis Report of the Little
11	Rock Police Department ("the Analysis Report") conducted by the Center for Public Safety Management
12	made it clear that the property and evidence unit for the Little Rock Police Department "is in terrible
13	condition and the current space available for storing items is completely inadequate for the Department's
14	needs "; and,
15	WHEREAS, the Analysis Report notes that currently there is a property and storage unit at 600 West
16	Markham Street, a hangar at the Little Rock National Airport, and an impound lot at the City Impound
17	Facility; and,
18	WHEREAS, an appropriate facility must be provided as quickly as possible.
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
20	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
21	Section 1. The City Manager, during the joint presentation of a budget with the Mayor, shall provide
22	an expense analysis to the Mayor and Board of Directors, and shall recommend funding sources, to
23	construct appropriate, secure and refrigerated property and storage facilities for the Little Rock Police
24	Department to be completed during and opened during 2023.
25	Section 2. Notwithstanding when the Mayor and City Manager will jointly present a proposed budget
26	to the Board of Directors, the City Manager shall fulfill and present to the Mayor and members of the Board
27	of Directors, a proposed budget which meets the requirements of this resolution no less than seven (7)
28	calendar days to any 2023 Budget discussion which may result in the approval of the 2023 Annual City
29	Budget.
30	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
31	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
32	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and

1	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged i	nvalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the	
2	resolution.		
3	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with		
4	the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. ADOPTED: November 15, 2022
