10	WHEREAS, the Fleet Services Landfill Maintenance Facility is in need of additional workspace for
11	maintenance on sanitation trucks; and,
12	WHEREAS, Bid No. 15145R was issued, and AMR Construction, LLC, submitted the most
13	responsive and responsible bid in the amount of Two Hundred Sixty-One Thousand, Five Hundred Fifty-
14	Two Dollars (\$261,552.00).
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
16	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
17	Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with
18	AMR Construction, LLC, to construct additional workspace at the Landfill Maintenance Facility in the
19	total construction cost of Two Hundred Sixty-One Thousand, Five Hundred Fifty-Two Dollars
20	(\$261,552.00).
21	Section 2. Funds for this construction are allocated in the Fleet Capital Fund.
22	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
23	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
24	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
25	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
26	resolution.
27	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent
28	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
