22	and easement abandonment for an undeveloped fifty (50)-foot Scenic Boulevard right-of-way located within		
23	the property at 55 Scenic Boulevard as recorded in Book 4, Page 235, Highlands Subdivision as recorded in		
24	Book 1, Page 273, with no retention of any easement rights, Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas.		
25	Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of such hearing in the manner prescribed by		
26	law by publication once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper published in Pulaski County,		
27	Arkansas, and having a general circulation in the City of Little Rock.		
28	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word		
29	of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication		
30	shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the		
31	portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.		
32	Section 4. Repealer. All resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this resolution are		

hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
