3	A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT
4	TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN
5	DEVELOPMENT THE AMENDED 2020 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AND
6	AMENDED 2016-2020 CONSOLIDATED PLAN TO INCLUDE
7	SUPPLEMENTAL ALLOCATION OF CDBG-CV3 FUNDS; AND FOR
8	OTHER PURPOSES.

10	WHEREAS, the City has access to CDBG Funds and a supplemental allocation of CDBG-CV Funds;
11	and,
12	WHEREAS, the use of these monies mandates that an action plan be submitted in accordance with the
13	requirements of Title I of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 and is normally
14	submitted by November 15th for the Program Year beginning January 1st; however, if the United States
15	Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) grants additional supplemental funding
16	allocations, the grantees must submit an amendment to their plans for a relevant plan year to the HUD Field
17	Offices of the proposed changes for approval; and,
18	WHEREAS, HUD will provide updated allocation amounts and will require a submission of the plan
19	upon request; and,
20	WHEREAS, the CDBG-CV3 supplemental allocation for the 2020 Program Year totals One Million,
21	Sixteen Thousand, Four Hundred Seventy-Seven Dollars (\$1,016,477.00).
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
23	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
24	Section 1. The Board of Directors recommends submission of the Amended 2020 Annual Action Plan
25	and Amended 2016-2020 Consolidated Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development
26	in accordance with the requirements of Title I of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act
27	of 1990 as HUD is granting additional supplemental funding.
28	Section 2. Further, the Board of Directors authorizes the City Manager to enter into Agreements for
29	Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funding with identified organizations for a period of one
30	(1)-year to provide services to prevent, prepare or mitigate the economic impact of the COVID-19
31	Pandemic. See Exhibit A attached.
32	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
33	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
34	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and

1	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the			
2	resolution.			
3	Section 4. Repealer. All resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this resolution are			
4	hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency including, but not limited to, Little Rock, Arkansas			
5	Resolution No. 15,170 (February 18, 2020) and Little Rock, Arkansas Resolution No. 15,211 (April 28,			
6	2020).
