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10	WHEREAS, Fleet Services Department has a need to provide oils and lubricants for use in various
11	vehicles currently in the City's fleet; and,
12	WHEREAS, the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, held a Public Bid No. 997 to obtain competitive bids
13	from qualified vendors for oil and lubricants; and,
14	WHEREAS, after a competitive bidding process with three (3) bids received, it was determined that
15	The McPherson Companies, Inc., was the lowest bidder for an annual contract awarded for a one (1)-year
16	contract term and two (2) additional one (1)-year renewals for an annual amount not to exceed One Hundred
17	Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00).
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
19	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
20	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an annual one (1)-year contract (APO) with
21	not more than two (2) additional one (1)-year renewal extensions for an annual budget amount not to exceed
22	One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) with The McPherson Companies, Inc.
23	Section 2. Funds for this purchase are to be allocated in the Fleet Services Parts Account No. 600013-
24	60310.
25	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
29	resolution.
30	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
31	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
