10	WHEREAS AL. C'r., SL'AL B. J		
11	WHEREAS, the City of Little Rock was granted ESG-CV (Emergency Solutions Grant) Funds made		
12 13	available pursuant to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act; and,		
	WHEREAS, the ESG-CV is designed to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the Coronavirus		
14 15	Pandemic (COVID-19) for individuals and families who are homeless or receiving homeless assistance;		
	and,		
16 17	WHEREAS, funds will also support additional homeless assistance and homelessness prevention activities to mitigate the impacts of COVID-19; and,		
18	WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Qualifications dated September 1, 2020, to procure a		
19	service provider for ESG-CV Assistance; and,		
20	WHEREAS, on October 12, 2020, World Services for the Blind was selected by the Selection		
21	Committee to provide ESG-CV Services in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars		
22	(\$100,000.00) over one (1)-year, with the City's option to extend the contract for one (1) additional year		
23	or a portion thereof, depending on service needs and the availability of funding with the right to terminate		
24	the agreement upon completion of the grant.		
25	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
26	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
27	Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with		
28	World Services for the Blind for one (1)-year, with the City's option to extend the contract for one (1)		
29	additional year, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for Emergency		
30	Solutions Covid-19 Grant (ESG-CV) Funding for Rapid-Rehousing and Homeless Prevention Services		
31	within the City of Little Rock, Arkansas.		
32	Section 2. The funds are available from the City's allocation of ESG-CV Funds from the Arkansas		
33	Department of Human Services.		

1	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, c		
2	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration of		
3	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
4	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the		
5	resolution.		
6	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsisten		
7	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
