

1 **Section 4. Severability.** In the event any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, subparagraph,
2 item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or
3 unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance,
4 as if such invalid or unconstitutional provision were not originally part of this ordinance.

5 **Section 5. Repealer.** All ordinances, resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this
6 ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency including, but not limited to, Little Rock,
7 Ark., Ordinance No. 21,342 (December 13, 2016).

8 **Section 6. Emergency Clause.** *The ability to have such coverage in place at all times is essential to*
9 *the public health, safety, and welfare, and therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance*
10 *shall be in full force and effect upon its passage so there is no questions that the City is a part of this pool*
11 *on January 1, 2018.*
