20	River City Hydraulic Company for the purchase of eight (8) Automated Side-Loader Refuse Trucks		
21	utilizing the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Contract, for the total amount of Two Million, One		
22	Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand, One Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$2,152,160.00).		
23	Section 2. Funds for this purchase are allocated in the Public Works Capital Assets – Vehicle		
24	account.		
25	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration of		
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force an		
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the		
29	resolution.		
30	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent		
31	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
