BACKGROUND CONTINUED

The study will include, but not necessarily be limited to, the following services:

- 1. Police Service
- 2. Fire Service necessary to maintain the Class 1 Rating for the City
- 3. Emergency Medical Services
- 4. Public Works Services including, but not limited to, road and street construction and repair including sidewalks and drainage; Solid Waste pick-up and disposal
- 5. Animal Services
- 6. Truancy Prosecution Services
- 7. Enforcement Services

A professional services request was issued for qualifications procedures through the Purchasing Department, and a selection committee was appointed by the City Manager to review the submitted qualifications. The Committee selected TischlerBise, Inc., as the most qualified to provide the needed services and a contract price was negotiated with TischlerBise, Inc., to initiate the study of all City services that may need to be provided to any part of the Extraterritorial Planning Jurisdiction of the City of Little Rock and for a report and presentation on the potential economic impact on the City.
