8	WHEREAS, Street resurfacing improvements are needed within the City of Little Rock to maintain
9	existing asphalt streets, and
10	WHEREAS, citizens of the City of Little Rock approved a bond issue which provided funding fo
11	these resurfacing improvements,
12	AND, Cranford Construction Company submitted the lowest bid (Bid No. 14,104) meeting
13	specifications for the 2014 Street Resurfacing Program and funding is available for additional stree
14	resurfacing improvements.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
16	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
17	SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Cranford
18	Construction Company to increase the contract amount not to exceed from Six Million, Three Hundred
19	Ninety-One Thousand, Twenty-Eight and 13/100 Dollars (\$6,391,028.13) to an amount not to exceed o
20	Eight Million, Thirty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,038,000.00) to resurface additional streets.
21	SECTION 2. Funding for this project is available from funding provided by Limited Tax General
22	Obligation Capital Improvement Bonds approved by citizens of the City of Little Rock.
23	SECTION 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase
24	or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
25	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
26	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
27	resolution.
28	SECTION 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsisten
29	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
30	SECTION 5. This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
