SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Arkansas Public Safety Solutions to replace and install security cameras in various City facilities.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The amount of \$1,000,000.00 was designated in the 2023 Budget Amendment that was approved by the Board of Directors on October 17, 2023, by Ordinance No. 22,328.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	This City currently has 319 Hikvision Security Cameras located in various City facilities. In 2019, the United States Government sanctioned Hikvision due to national security concerns regarding potential access to camera video and data without the owner's knowledge. In 2021, the United States Government ultimately banned the sale and distribution of Hikvision altogether. Due to potential risk to the City's network, the Information Technology Department recommended the replacement of all Hikvision Cameras located in City facilities.	
	An inventory of all cameras located within City facilities was taken, and an assessment of additional trouble spots was determined in various City Parks, along with the Neighborhood Resource Centers.	

BACKGROUND CONTINUED

On October 17, 2023, the Board approved a Budget Amendment to the 2023 Budget by Ordinance No. 22,328. Included in the Budget Amendment was an allocation of \$1,000,000.00 to begin the first phase of the replacement of the Hikvision Security Cameras, which includes Little Rock City Hall, Little Rock Police Headquarters and various Parks locations. Purchase will made utilizing The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS USA), Contract No. 220605.
