11	WHEREAS, Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc., was selected through a professional Statement of
12	Qualifications process for Engineering Consultant Services, Bid No. 11,249, to provide design services for
13	the North Cantrell Road Bridge Replacement Project, Arkansas Department of Transportation Job No.
14	061423; and,
15	WHERAS, it is desirable to increase the contract ceiling price to provide for additional design services
16	to accommodate the upcoming Viaduct Replacement Project on Cantrell Road.
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
18	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
19	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to approve an amendment to the contract with Jacobs
20	Engineering Group, Inc., for engineering services and to increase the contract ceiling price by Ninety-Six
21	Thousand, Five Hundred Seven Dollars (\$96,507.00), to a new contract total of Three Hundred Twenty-
22	Six Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars (\$326,200.00).
23	Section 2. This Arkansas Department of Transportation Grant Project was originally authorized by
24	Resolution No. 13,601. Funding of the City share will be from the Capital Improvement Bonds for Streets
25	and Drainage and the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax for constructing Street
26	and Drainage Improvement Projects.
27	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
28	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
29	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
30	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
