BACKGROUND	The term of the contracts shall be for six (6) months beginning January 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2019, with an understanding that the City ratifies, accepts, and will compensate any work done between January 1, 2019, and the effective date of the approved contract. The contract may be considered for one (1), six (6)-month extension period beginning July 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2019, upon the successful contract compliance of the first	

six (6)-month term.

BACKGROUND CONTINUED

A review committee consisting of citizens and representatives of local community-based organizations met to evaluate the qualifications and responses of the various non-profit organizations of which the above applicants met the minimum qualifications for funding consideration. The Commission on Children, Youth & Families then met and voted to endorse these organizations for a contract award to provide After-School/Out-of-School Time Youth Intervention Programs.
