SYNOPSIS FISCAL IMPACT	Extension of the current contracts with two (2) non-profit organizations to provide Positive Prevention Programs, seven (7) non-profit organizations to provide Youth Intervention Programs, and two (2) non-profit organizations to provide Re-Entry Services for a period of six (6) months. Extension of the contract with two (2) non-profit organizations to Provide Positive Prevention Programs and the seven (7) non-profit organizations to provide Youth Intervention Programs is up to \$37,500. Extension of the separate contract with two (2) non-profit organizations to provide Re-Entry Services is up to \$30,000. Funds for these programs will be from the 2018 PIT Allocation, and the account numbers will be set up when the 2018 Budget is approved.

BACKGROUND	Review panels, consisting of representatives of local community-based organizations, Children Youth and Families (CYF) Commission members, and private business previously met in early 2017, reviewed applications; and recommended these non-profit organizations for the relative Program for Little Rock youth.

The CYF Commission met on December 6, 2017, and voted to endorse these organizations for this contract award extension.

The term of the contracts shall be six (6) months beginning January 1, 2018, and ending no later than June 30, 2018, with an understanding that the City ratifies, accepts and will compensate any work done between January 1, 2018, and the effective date of the approved resolution.
