SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with ShotSpotter, Inc., d/b/a SST, Inc., for an additional one (1)-year period from December 19, 2022, through December 18, 2023.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The amount of this project is \$149,500.00, plus applicable taxes and fees, and funds in the amount of \$99,000.00 will be paid from Federal Asset Forfeiture-Treasury and \$50,000.00 will be paid from Crime Guns Grant, Account No. 270529-G35167.

BACKGROUND	ShotSpotter operates on the principle of multilateration, based upon the precise time the sound of gunfire arrives at each senor utilizing audio sensors installed on top of buildings or on poles in the designated service area and the cloud-based, subscription manages service offering, and multiple sensors pick up on the guns shot's sound and transmits data to the SST cloud-based server, where the company's proprietary software analyzes the data to classify the incident and determine the exact location.	

BACGROUND

It is critical that the Little Rock Police Department continue be equipped and trained with reliable forms of response intervention equipment to preserve public safety.

The proposed services will be delivered according to the terms and conditions contained in the Agreement between the City of Little Rock and ShotSpotter dated August 10, 2018, as amended to reflect the revisions in Amendment Once, which is incorporated herein by reference.

The service contract was previously-approved with Resolution No. 15,392 (February 16, 2021).
