29	in an amount not to exceed Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) per organization to provi	ide
30	After-School/Out-of-School Time Positive Prevention Programs for a period of twelve (12) mon	ths
31	beginning January 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2019:	
32	1. Life Skills for Youth Southwest 6-11	
33	2. My Sister's Keeper Far West 6-11 or 12/17	

1 Section 2. Funds for these programs are from the 2019 PIT Allocation, Account No. 108159-2 S15A923. 3 Section 3. (a) The term for each contract listed in Section 1 of this resolution shall be for a period of 4 twelve (12) months with a start date of January 1, 2019, and an understanding that the City ratifies, 5 accepts, and will compensate any work done between January 1, 2019, and the effective date of the 6 approved contract. 7 Section 4. All payments are conditioned upon entry into contracts for services that are in a form 8 acceptable to the City Attorney; further, nothing in this resolution prevents the City from being able to 9 offer similar services to any vendor during 2019 if, it its sole discretion, it decides to do so. 10 Section 5. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or 11 12 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and 13 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the 14 resolution. 15 Section 6. Repealer.
