**BACKGROUND** There is no public need for the right-of-way. The right-ofway was never developed as a street and the area of right-ofway proposed for abandonment is located entirely within the applicant's property. Once the right-of-way is abandoned, the applicant proposes to develop the entirety of the property as a single home site.
