17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
18	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
19	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to pursue the acquisition of permanent construction		
20	easements, right-of-way dedications, fee simple acquisitions, and temporary construction easements as		
21	need to complete the projects identified in Resolution No. 14,310 as amended.		
22	Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to accept permanent construction easements, right-of-way		
23	dedications and fee simple acquisitions for municipal purposes and the City Manager is authorized to		
24	accept temporary easements needed for construction.		
25	Section 3. Funding for acquisition of easements and dedications is from the amounts allocated to		
26	each Ward for the projects.		
27	Section 4. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
28	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
29	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
30	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the		
31	resolution.		
32	Section 5. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with		
33	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
