BACKGROUND	There have been numerous Code hearings and research performed by the National Fire Protection Association, the general public and numerous professionals before Code adoption. On the State level, the Code has been adopted by the Arkansas Department of Labor after an extensive review process. At the City level, it has been discussed with the local contracting trades and has been open for public review at the City Clerk's Office per Arkansas State Statute. In addition, notices were sent to various construction organizations.
